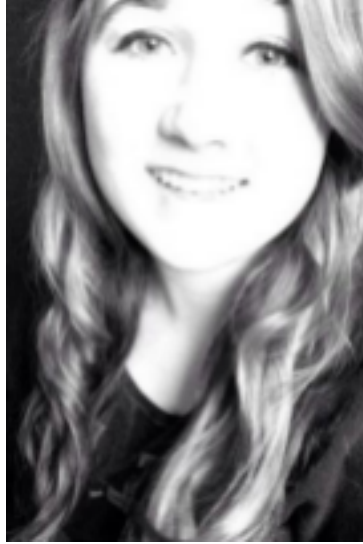


**The Haley Wilson
